#### QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Today female adolescent anorexia is a very dangerous condition (the mortality rate is 10.5%, from some statistics). This mortality rate usually depends on the fact that the diagnosis is made too late. Dr. Bracco's new perspective about anorexia permits us to reach a *very early diagnosis* of "adolescent female anorexia" and even to formulate a hypothesis of risk (*predictive diagnosis*) before adolescence.
